A meaningful education starts with the right foundation. RLI staff and instructors need your assistance to create the best learning experience possible for you and your fellow LANDU® course participants. Therefore, when you register for a LANDU® course you agree to the list below.

As a LANDU learner, I agree to:

- Arrive on time and be prepared to learn.
- Download course materials from the RLI Education Portal prior to the start of class and opened on the computer.
- Carefully read all emails from RLI pertaining to your course.
- Have the technology needed to be successful in the course, including a computer with a reliable internet connection and current version of an Internet browser.
- **Virtual (VILT) Courses:** Have the Zoom app downloaded to my device at least 24 hours prior to start of class. (Our staff is unavailable for Zoom tech support. If you need support, [contact Zoom](#).)
- Have the most recent version of Microsoft Excel downloaded to my computer and ready to use. (I understand that this is a requirement if taking the *Land Investment Analysis* course and that RLI staff is unavailable for tech support.)
- Give feedback on the post-course survey.
- Not share course materials, test questions, or test answers.
- Abide by the RLI Learner AI Use Policy:
 - “The use of generative AI tools (such as ChatGPT, etc.) are not permitted in class, either in-person or virtual formats, as well as the ALC Comprehensive Final Exam. Students are strictly prohibited from using AI tools to assist with any exams, case studies, and group activities, unless otherwise specifically instructed. Therefore, any unauthorized use of AI tools for work in any class may be considered a violation of REALTORS Land Institute code of conduct and learner agreement, since the work is not your own, and may result in penalties at the discretion of RLI leadership.
